There are 9 scheduled PPC 600 matches and 9 scheduled Service 480 matches. To be eligible for prizes in the 2017-18 season each shooter will post at least 7 scores for each Match. No more than 6 pre or post shoots. Must shoot at least once at each of the 3 clubs.

General Rules

- All standard NRA PPC rules apply.
- No hi-speed or magnum ammo.
- No Cross draw holsters
- Make up matches allowed for PPC or Service 2 pre-shoots and 2 post shoots each.
- All scores are final.
- Lines start at 7:00PM SHARP please be on time.
- Last line starts at 8:30PM NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Autos allowed no compensators.
- \$5.00 per line with \$1.00 returned to the host club.

Course of Fire - PPC 600

String 1: 7 yds....12 rds. in 20 seconds. String 2: 20 yds.18 rds. in 90 seconds.

6 rds. Kneeling

6 rds. Left Barricade

6 rds. Right Barricade

String 3: 20 yds. 6 rds. in 12 seconds.

String 4: 20 yds.24 rds. in 2min45sec.

6 rds. Sitting

6 rds. Prone

6 rds. Left Barricade

6 rds. Right Barricade

Service Match Rules:

- Service matches will be shot separate from regular PPC.
- - Any revolver 4" or less w/ adjustable sights, or 5" or less w/ fixed sights.
- Any service auto, must have a minimum of (4) magazines.
- Snubbies and prohibs welcome, must load (6) rounds at a time.
- No compensated/IPSC/full house race guns or PPC guns allowed.
- \$5.00 per line with \$1.00 returned to the host club

Course of Fire - Service Pistol

The course of fire for this match is adapted from the Canadian Police Combat Association. It consists of 4 stages on 1 target totalling 48 rounds.

STAGE 1: 5 YARDS: 12 rds. in total; all from low ready

- 2 rounds in 3 seconds, strong hand only.
- 2 rounds in 3 seconds, strong hand only
- 2 rounds strong hand, reload, 2 rounds weak hand in 12 seconds
- 2 rounds in 3 seconds, weak hand only.
- 2 rounds in 3 seconds, weak hand only.

STAGE 2: 7 YARDS: 12 rds. in total; all from holster, all strong hand only.

- 3 rounds in 5 seconds and re-holster
- 3 rounds, reload and 3 rounds in 12 sec. then re-holster.
- 3 rounds in 5 seconds.

STAGE 3: 10 YARDS: 12 rds. in total; all from holster, standing position, all two handed.

- 3 rounds in 5 seconds and re-holster
- 3 rounds, reload and 3 rounds in 12 sec. then re-holster.
- 3 rounds in 5 seconds.

STAGE 4. 15 YARDS....12 rds. in 20 seconds. Draw from holster, all two handed. Standing position,

 a) From standing position draw and fire 6 rounds unsupported, reload and fire 6 rounds unsupported in 20 seconds
